Who is Eligible to Apply?

- The cohort is open to all educators from the Cook County School Districts.
- Applicants must have at least two years of teaching or school support personnel experience (Type 73) by fall 2018.



- The cohort is tentatively scheduled to begin in fall 2018 with a completion date of summer 2020.
- All decisions with respect to class time, day, etc. will be made by consensus with the participants.
- All classes during Year 1 will be held at the NCISC/ ROE in Des Plaines. Year 2 classes will be held at NEIU's main campus located at 5500 N. St. Louis Ave., Chicago, IL 60625.
- Year 1: Students will take two classes per semester -back to back- one night per week.
- Year 2: Students will take one class per semester and complete their year-long internship. All students keep their current full-time jobs while completing the internship.
